

Curriculum for M.P.H. in Health Management (Second Year Students)

The M.P.H. degree requires a total of 20 course units. The M.P.H. in Health Management requires the student to complete or acquire an exemption from the following courses. All “a” courses are offered in the fall term, and “b” courses are offered in the spring term. Full time students must carry a minimum of 4 course units each semester.
